Weeds don't take time off ... Neither Can You!




A post harvest burndown:

- Reduces seed bank in the following crop
- * Reduces weed population in next crop
- Helps fight resistance
- Makes weed management easier and less costly

The battle of weed control is a numbers game. Reduce the weeds and eliminate the seed to win the war. This has to be a year-round battle because weeds do not take time off.



Cleaner Fields Improve Yields

Keys to Post Harvest Burndown:

- Be timely after harvest
- Use a good burn down material
- Add a residual or come back in late fall with residual material
- Use Spectrum in your burndown program
